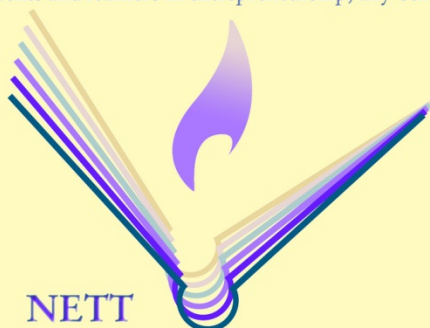


NETT is a project for improving the entrepreneurship teaching in the European Educational System.

Expected Impacts:

Through the NETT platform the teachers in the entrepreneurship education will have the opportunity of **sharing best practices, creating network opportunities, develop self- and peer assessment process, innovate their teaching methods, improve transversal skills and competencies, practices and opportunities.**

NETT project will improve the situation of both the direct and indirect target groups. They will have the chance to **easily access** everywhere from Europe a **high quality education tool** directly linked with their professional practice and networking with colleagues (for teachers) and the chance to benefit of a more **innovative and high quality teaching approach** (for learners) more in line with their learning objectives, learning styles and entrepreneurship education innovations.

The institutions – consortium members will substantially strengthen their capacity in providing tools, services and educational content on entrepreneurship education. The piloted innovative services and digital repositories could be smartly integrated into the NETT project infrastructure.

The institutions in the consortium will be also able to multiply the effect of the NETT impact at European level.

NETT Platform:

An Internet open platform will be set up in a cloud for:

- **exchanging** content, tools and methods between entrepreneurship teachers;
- **creating** community of practice;
- **providing** courses for entrepreneurial skills developing.

The platform will support, with the most **advanced technologies**, a **Social Community** where people involved in entrepreneurship education will debate on this topic and find concrete helps for realizing an European way of training young people to become entrepreneurs, yet in respect of local industrial and commercial frameworks.
